The Writing on the Wall

Verse of the Week: "Teach us to number our days so we can have a wise heart" (Psalm 90:12).

Daily Prayer: Almighty God, write your Word on our hearts. Teach us to number our days, to weigh our hearts, and to work for your kingdom for your glory. Amen.

Introduction to this week's Scripture readings: This week's readings focus on taking stock of our own faithfulness to God. It's a good opportunity to ask the question, "What would God write on your wall?"

Daily Scripture Readings:

Monday - Psalm 90 - A prayer for the wise use of our days Tuesday - Romans 1:1-25 - The problem of idolatry Wednesday - Jeremiah 2:1-13 - Jeremiah's warning Thursday - Joshua 24:14-24 - Joshua's challenge to faithfulness Friday - Hebrews 12:1-17 - Running the race with discipline Saturday - 1 John 4:1-6 - Testing the spirits

Questions for Reflection/Journaling/Discussion:

- 1. How did you respond to this week's message? What insights and questions did it raise for you?
- 2. What word might God write on the walls of our culture? Our government? Our church? Your own home? What idols are we prone to worship?
- 3. How do you "number your days?" Does knowing that your days are numbered changed how you use your time? In what ways?
- 4. What common thread do you see through this week's readings? How would you define faithfulness to God?

Intercessory Prayer Guide:

Monday - Pray for God to reveal opportunities to share your faith this week. **Tuesday -** Pray for those who may be hostile to people of faith, for a softening of the heart and an opening for the Holy Spirit.

Wednesday - Pray for those requests listed on our TLUMC prayer list and prayer wall.

Thursday - Pray for our Blueprints Class as it begins this week and for those joining TLUMC in worship and mission.

Friday - Pray for those who are struggling with idolatry in their lives.

Saturday - Pray for those who will attend worship at TLUMC this Sunday. Pray that God's Spirit would prompt new people join us to hear and respond to his Word.


