# **Devotion Guide**

#### Daily Devotional Guide Week 6: Goodness

#### Verse of the Week:

He has shown you, O mortal, what is good. And what does the Lord require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God. (Micah 6:8, NIV)

#### **Daily Prayer:**

Dear heavenly Father, I praise you for being so kind, gentle, and patient with me. When I consider the difference between how much I know and how well I love, I am compelled to worship you for the truth and riches of the gospel. You don't love me to the degree I love others; you love me to the degree you have hidden my life in Christ, which is completely. This good news is my peace, hope, and my joy. Help me to extend your goodness to others. Amen.

#### **Daily Scripture Readings:**

Monday – Psalm 15	Tuesday – Genesis 1:1-31	Wednesday – Galatians 6:1-10
Thursday – Matthew 5:13-16	<b>Friday</b> – 1 Timothy 6:11-19	Saturday – Titus 3:1-8

#### **Questions for Reflection/Journaling/Discussion:**

- 1. Looking back on this week's message: what stood out to you? What challenged you? What new insights did you gain? What will you do differently as a result?
- 2. Based on this week's message and your reading from the Scriptures, how do you think God defines a "good" person?
- 3. What is your reaction to the parable of the workers in the vineyard? With whom do you identify most in this parable?
- 4. The prophet Micah outlines "what is good." How are you doing justice, overcoming evil with good, and walking humbly with God in your life this week?

#### **Intercessory Prayer Guide:**

**Monday** - Our culture is all about people getting what they deserve. Pray that God would soften your heart to be good to others even when they don't deserve it.

**Tuesday** - As you read the news today, ask God to reveal to you where you might "do justice" and lift up the least, the last, and the lost around you.


Wednesday - Pray for those in our church who are in need (use the weekly prayer list).

**Thursday** - Thank God for his goodness toward you. Be specific in naming some ways in which God has provided for you in ways you didn't deserve.

**Saturday** - Pray for our worship services on Sunday and that TLUMC would continue to be a church where people encounter the goodness of God.


