The Nine Essentials Week 2: Joy

Verse of the Week:

"This day is holy to our Lord; do not be grieved, for the joy of the Lord is your strength." - Nehemiah 8:10b

Daily Prayer:

Gladden the soul of your servant, for to you, O Lord, I lift up my soul. For you, O Lord, are good and forgiving, abounding in steadfast love to all who call on you. - Psalm 86:4-5

Questions for Reflection/Journaling/Discussion:

- 1. Looking back at this week's message, what stood out to you? What challenged you? What new insights did you gain? What will you do differently as a result?
- 2. This week's Scripture readings focus on the paradoxical nature of joy—that we can have joy even in the midst of difficult circumstances. How would you differentiate joy from "happiness?"
- 3. What are the ways in which you "return to joy" after difficulty? If you struggle with returning to joy, what steps might you take toward living more joyfully?
- 4. In this week's message, Pastor Bob listed three reasons for the Christian to live joyfully. How do you cultivate joy in these areas of your life?

Intercessory Prayer Guide:

Monday - Pray through the newspaper or your daily news feed - pray for those in need of family, faith, and a future.

Tuesday - Pray through the TLUMC prayer list from Sunday.

Wednesday - Pray for a cultivation of the fruit of joy among Christians, especially those facing persecution and difficulty.

Thursday - Pray for those around you at work, school, or wherever you find yourself. Ask God to help you spread joy today.

Friday - Pray for those who struggle with joy today—those dealing with depression, anxiety, grief, and addiction.

Saturday - Pray for tomorrow's worship services at TLUMC, that they may be joyful and increase the worshipers' capacity for joy!


