Questions for Reflection/Journaling/Discussion:

1. Looking back on this week's message: what stood out to you? What challenged you? What new insights did you gain? What will you do differently as a result?
2. How do you respond to the statement that God's love is both “unconditional” and “conditioning?” How has God's love and the love of other Christians conditioned you? How might our love for others help “condition” them toward becoming more the image of God they were created to be?
3. This week's daily Scriptures are all about love. How do the Scriptures compare and contrast to our culture's view of love? How would you define “love” based on your reading?
4. What does God's love mean to you? How might you share it with others this week? Think of specific people to whom you can demonstrate unconditional and conditioning love.

Tuesday - Pray for those in our church who are in need (use the weekly prayer list).
