Sermon Outline for Enjoying Disobedience

Scripture: Romans 1:32 (KJV) Who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them.

Subject: Enjoying Disobedience

Introduction: It's not what you did but what you're doing!

Aim: For us to have a Spiritual E.K.G. (I heard it said, that "Sin cannot be allowed to go on unchecked")

Definition: Disobedience - A failure or refusal to obey rules or someone in authority.

Introductory Examples:

- A. Diets
- B. Degrees
- C. Do Not's (Do not touch wet paint / Do not walk on grass /Do not talk)

Points to Consider:

- I. Enjoyment.
(Even though there is pleasure in sin, it does not condemn us, unless we practice it.)
 - A. Pleasure
 - B. Practice

- II. Embarrassment.
(We should never take pride in our sins nor condone them being done in private.)
 - A. Pride
 - B. Private

- III. Endorsement.
(That makes us a party to the crime, as well as, promoting it.)
 - A. Party
 - B. Promotion
