Scripture: James 4:17 (KJV) Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin.

Subject: The Great Omission!

Introduction: Someone said that if you know better you ought to do better.

Aim: For us to see that some things are too important not to do.

Definition (Webster): Omission - Something neglected or left undone.

- II. Get Over our Independence and Pride.
 - A. Independence
 - B. Pride
- III. Good Opportunities if we won't Ignore Problems.
 - A. Ignore
 - B. Problems
